SUMMARY:

Paul Hansen, 1120 Jenifer Street, registered in support. Mr. Hansen briefly described the proposed garage project. Mr. Hansen explained that the proposed garage would meet zoning side yard setbacks. Mr. Hansen explained that in communicating with staff, he agrees to square the glass on the garage door and remove the decorative hinges.

Staff explained that this proposal started as a 10 foot by 12 foot garden shed and then it changed to a 12 foot by 18 foot garage structure. The shed could be administratively approved, but he garage needs the review of the Landmarks Commission.

Mr. Hansen stated that there is vinyl siding on the main residence and that the siding and details on the garage will match the residence.
