- MFD supports the allowance of the (3) northeast balcony locations adjacent to Henry Street.
- Washington Place is a private drive and not a public right of way. If a permanent No Build Easement can be or has been established for Washington Place, MFD would support the allowance of the (2) southwest balcony locations.
- Regarding the (4) northwest balcony locations, the design team is proposing to establish an imaginary property line
 and a No Build Easement. The location and extent of the no build easement shall permit the location of the
 imaginary property line to be established and would allow both the proposed building and the existing building to
 be in complete compliance with the building code regarding setbacks, exterior wall ratings and allowable
 openings.
- MFD does not support the encroachment of the proposed (2) balcony locations between the proposed building in
 the air rights and the existing building at 58 S Henry Street. Only 10-ft of separation distance shown between
 buildings at this point. This separation distance allows a path of fire and smoke spread between buildings.
- The (2) proposed balcony locations on either side of the 309 W Washington Ave fresh air intake creates a path of
 fire and smoke spread around the 3-hr horizontal fire separation. MFD does not support the current proposed
 location of these balconies in relation to the location of the fresh air intake.
- All patios and balconies that have a balcony or roof above shall be protected with automatic fire sprinklers.
- The building shall be constructed to Type IB standards. Any reductions and/or exceptions to reduce active or
 passive fire protection shall not be allowed.
- Other than the proposed variance to IBC 706.1, any other variances shall require re-evaulation of all petitions for this project to allow a thorough evaluation of the project as a whole.
