Title

Declaring the band State Radio and its members, Chad Urmston, Chuck Fay, and Mike Najarian, honorary citizens of the great City of Madison, Wisconsin.

Body

WHEREAS, State Radio has visited Madison and played concerts here at least seven times since 2005, including sold out shows at the Orpheum Theatre; and,

WHEREAS, during Chad Urmston's last visit to Madison he visited State Street and played in front of the State Capitol Building; and,

WHEREAS, the band's lyrics have created awareness of issues surrounding human rights in Darfur, conscientious objection to war, and poverty; and,

WHEREAS, the band put activism back in Madison through a non-profit organization called "Calling All Crows" as a way to motivate people through music; and,

WHEREAS, Calling All Crows has raised over \$250,000 and invested more than 20,000 hours of service in local communities across North America and Europe; and,

WHEREAS, the group will be in City of Madison participating with Habitat for Humanity to help construct an affordable home on the North side; and,

WHEREAS, while the band hails from Sherborn, Massachusetts, the City of Madison looks forward to this visit by State Radio and wishes the band best wishes on their upcoming tour,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council and Mayor declare the band State Radio and its members, Chad Urmston, Chuck Fay, and Mike Najarian, honorary citizens of the great City of Madison, Wisconsin.
