

PUBLIC NOTICE

AT&T will be extending its fiber optic network within the City of Madison during the Month of December 2012. This work is being done in order to enhance existing facilities in the Madison Area.

There will be a public hearing, before the City of Madison Board of Public Works, on Wednesday, November 28, 2012 at 5:30 p.m. in Room 108 of the City-County Building 210 Martin Luther King Jr Blvd.

Cable installation contractors hired by AT&T will install fiber cables within the Roadway limits at the following location:

 Beginning at 4002 Monona Dr, heading east along the south side of Davidson St, then crossing Davidson St and continuing on the north side of the street to Demspey Rd. Thence north on the west side of Dempsey Rd. to Cottage Grove Rd. Thence west along the south side of Cottage Grove Rd to the front of 3901 Dempsey Rd. Handhole (access points) will be placed at the following locations: Front of 101 Davidson St. Front of 3909 Dempsey Rd.

Cable will be directional bored and placed in the public ROW.

Restoration of any damage within the limits of the road right-of-way will be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications. All damaged sidewalk slabs will be replaced with 5" lift concrete. All damage done to grass between sidewalk and curb will be restored with a four inch covering of black dirt and seed. All restoration required within the traveled portion of the roadway will also be completed in accordance with the City of Madison's standard specifications.
