


WIC Participation by Year




County Participation

Madison Participation












Breastfeeding Outcomes Compared to State in 2012




Breastfeeding Outcomes at PHMDC 2010-2012




Healthy Birth Outcomes Compared to State in 2012



Birth Outcome Indicators




Nutrition & Health Outcomes Compared to State in 2012




