
### The Chance Dance Festival

Proposed by Victoria Iannuzzi, Courtney Kuhn, and Kathleen Warner



# Art on the Side Show


Proposed by Mary Jane Connor

  - Decoration (\$797), Structural materials (\$77), Generator rental (\$240), advertisement (\$100), tax (\$67)












# Wish Wheel

  - Publicity/openings (\$960), signage (\$540)






After the winners are declared, all food will be donated to the MOM Food Pantry. In 2011, Canstruction® Madison raised 20 tons of food for area families in need.
