## **Event Description**

#### A. Schedule of Events

# B. Site Map/Route (Please see attached map)

The start line is on Vilas Park Drive even with the Vilas Park Shelter. Participants will be marshaled on Vilas Park Drive according to themed start waves. Participants will head northwest on Vilas Park Drive and then take a left onto Edgewood Drive. Next, they will take a right onto Woodrow Street and then turn right into the Edgewood College parking lot at the Woodrow Street gate. Participants will head east through the parking lot all the way to Edgewood Avenue. At Edgewood Avenue, participants will turn right heading down the hill and then turn left (heading east) on the Vilas Park path. Participants will continue on the path to the main entrance of Henry Vilas Zoo. Participants will then head through the Zoo, coming out onto Vilas Park Drive. Participants will then head east on Vilas Park Drive and make a turn around just before

South Mills Street. To finish up, participants will head over the two bridges in Vilas Park into the finish line that is in the middle of the park.

#### '80s Finish Party

The finish party will be a celebration of '80s music, fashion and pop culture. The party will include a costume contest, trivia contest, and lots of '80s music (via a sound system). We also plan to serve soda and beer/wine coolers via a licensed bartender. Venue will be contained with crowd control barricades and licensed alcohol area will be separate and distinct from non-licensed (under-aged) area. See included diagram.

#### C. Safety and Security Plan:

- Participants will line up in the designated staging area (Vilas Park Drive).
- Announcements will be ongoing instructing participants of procedures.
- · Volunteers will be stationed at key intersections/turns directing runners/walkers.
- · Police will be utilized at key intersections, based on Madison Police input.
- Fixed course marshals will be stationed at intersections and key spots on the course to control pedestrian/bicycle traffic while event participants pass
- Bicycle course marshals will lead and shelter the runners in advance and to the side of the route, traveling with the participants to create a safe envelope for the lead, middle and the last of the participants.
- "Chill Stations" will be located at the 1K, 2K, 3K and 4K markers. The 1K, 2K and 4K stations will be staffed by volunteers handing out '80s-themed souvenirs. The 3K Aid Station will be located in the Zoo and will have water, Kool Aid, bathrooms (Zoo restrooms), and medical personnel stationed there.
- Additional medical personnel will be available and visible with the finish venue for any minor injuries and triage. If emergency transport is necessary along the route, at the venue or at the Chill Stations, Run Back To The '80s personnel will initiate 911.
- The finish party will occur in Vilas Park adjacent the finish line. A separate and distinct licensed alcohol area will be fenced per permitting guidelines and include the double layer of perimeter fence with adequate ingress/egress locations managed by qualified security personnel inspecting ID's for entry and preventing patrons leaving with alcohol. Dispensing of alcohol will end at 8:00 p.m. if not prior.
- In the case of inclement weather, participants will take cover in the Vilas Park Shelter. Event staff will be monitoring the threat of impending weather throughout the day and have plans in place for the potential of canceling or postponing the event based on weather. Event staff also has access to participant contact information as well as emergency contact information.

### D. Clean Up and Recycling Plan

The majority of consumables will be disposed/recycled at Vilas Park (start and finish line)

- The Aid Stations crew will be responsible for cleaning up trash, etc. around their stations (Edgewood College and Henry Vilas Zoo).
- A paid environmental crew will be responsible for checking the route for trash as the
  event concludes, and ensuring that the venue is free of any trash at the end of the event.

# E. Notification Requirements

We will contact Alderperson Sue Ellingson to share information about the event as well as post event notices in the park, and work with the Zoo and Edgewood College/Edgewood High School to promote and post notices about the event.

# F.Certificate of Insurance

A certificate of insurance naming the City of Madison and its Park Division as an additional insured will be submitted a minimum of 45 days prior to the event.
