


## Why is this a PH issue?


- Fourth leading cause of death in WI (HP 2020)
- Consequences of Excessive Alcohol Use (CDC)
  - liver cirrhosis; pancreatitis; various cancers; high blood pressure; and psychological disorders
  - Unintentional injuries
  - Violence
  - Fetal alcohol spectrum disorders
  - Sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS)
  - Alcohol abuse or dependence
- Burden of Excessive Alcohol Report (UW PHI)





## Harm to Youth (CDC)

- Alcohol use before age 15: 5X more likely to become dependent than at age 21.
- Other risks
  - Unwanted, unprotected sexual behaviors
  - Poor school performance
  - Suicide
  - Homicide
