- Review ongoing research opportunities

3) PHMDC will focus on effective and efficient policies and programs

- Assure that current and future services are responsive to gaps and opportunities reflected in community health data
- Use best practice and evidence-based practices

4) PHMDC will build partnerships with others

- Partner with others to carry out community-based prevention
- Create more robust connections to other local governmental and non-profit agencies
- Work with local health care institutions and others for outbreak control, chronic disease management, health promotion, prevention of disease, and emergency preparedness
- Expand links to academic institutions to partner for community-based research
