A motion was made by Slattery, seconded by Gehrig, to convey to the Plan Commission that the Landmarks Commission raised concerns about maintaining the habitability of all structures so that demolition is not requested due to condition as is the case with 5238 Lake Mendota Drive and that the Landmarks Commission is concerned and regrets the continued loss of the historic character and fabric of Monroe Street as each area and style of gas station design contributes to the narrative of the neighborhood.
