
The Zoning Board of Appeals shall not grant a variance unless it finds that the applicant has shown the following standards are met:


<ol> <li>There are conditions unique to the property of the applicant that do not apply generally to other properties in the district.</li> </ol>
The properties along this stretch of Regent St. feature
steep slopes with the homes sited with busements higher than
the street level. nog Recent Leature grade slopes over 50% at the west side lot line & 34% at the driveway/east lot line.
2. The variance is not contrary to the spirit, purpose, and intent of the regulations in the zoning district and is not contrary to the public interest.
The proposed garage addition is common to this stretch




