At its June 3, 2013 meeting, the Plan Commission found the standards met and **approved** your conditional use application for 2318 Atwood Avenue, subject to the conditions below. In order to receive final approval of the conditional use, and for any necessary permits to be issued for your project, the following conditions shall be met:

- This property has private encroachments within the adjacent city of Madison owned "East Rail Corridor".
   The City of Madison Office of Real Estate Services is currently administering a lease with the property owner.
   The lease shall be finalized and recorded prior to issuance of final occupancy permits. If the property owner has any questions regarding the lease, contact Office of Real Estate Services Real Estate Agent Heidi Fischer at 264-9297 or hfischer@cityofmadison.com
- The applicant shall submit, prior to plan sign-off, digital PDF files to the Engineering Division (Jeff Benedict or Tim Troester). Digital copies shall be to scale, and shall have a scale bar on the plan set.

PDF submittals shall contain the following information:

- a) Building footprints
- b) Internal walkway areas
- c) Internal site parking areas
- d) Lot lines and right-of-way lines
- e) Street names
- f) Stormwater Management Facilities
- g) Detail drawings associated with Stormwater Mgmt Facilities (including if applicable planting plans)

When the applicant shall submit plans for approval, the applicant shall show the following: items in the terrace as existing (e.g., signs and street light poles), type of surfaces, existing and proposed property lines, addresses, one contiguous plan (showing all easements, all pavement markings, building placement, and stalls), adjacent driveway approaches to lots on either side and across the street, signage, percent of slope, semitrailer movements and vehicle routes, dimensions of radii, aisles, driveways, stalls including the two (2) feet overhang, and a scaled drawing at 1" = 20'. Contact City Traffic Engineering if you have questions.
- 6. The Developer shall post a deposit and reimburse the City for all costs associated with any modifications to Traffic Signals, Street Lighting, Signing and Pavement Marking, and conduit and handholes, including labor, engineering and materials for both temporary and permanent installations.
- 7. Public signing and marking related to the development may be required by the City Traffic Engineer for which the developer shall be financially responsible.

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Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency. No interior, exterior or structural demolition or wrecking activities or remodeling activities (including material reclamation activities by the applicant or a third party) shall commence nor any wrecking or building permits be issued until the applicant has met all of the conditions of approval stated in this letter. Please now follow the procedures listed below for obtaining your conditional use permit:

- 1. Please revise the plans per the above conditions and file **six (6)** sets of complete, fully dimensioned, and to-scale plans, along with the appropriate site plan review application and fee pursuant to Section 28.206 of the Zoning Code. Also provide any other documentation requested herein with the Zoning Administrator, Room LL-100, Madison Municipal Building, 215 Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard.
- 2. This letter shall be signed by the applicant to acknowledge the conditions of approval and returned to the Zoning Administrator when requesting building permit approval.
- 3. No alteration of this proposal shall be permitted unless approved by the Plan Commission, provided, however, the Zoning Administrator may issue permits for minor alterations. This approval shall become null and void one year after the date of the Plan Commission unless the use is commenced, construction is under way, or a valid building permit is issued and construction commenced within six months of the issuance of said building permit. The Plan Commission shall retain jurisdiction over this matter for the purpose of resolving complaints against the approved conditional use.
