The City of Madison is proposing to install storm sewer improvements on W. Oakbrook Circle at Sandy Court in 2013. This proposed project will include assessments to the adjacent property owners, and you are being sent this letter as notification of a public hearing before the Board of Public Works regarding the project, at the above referenced date, time & location. City Engineering will make a short presentation at the meeting, followed by the public hearing. The project will involve special assessments to owners of property adjacent to the project. Attached to this letter is a Schedule of Assessments, which shows the estimated costs for each property adjacent to the project.

The proposed project limits are as follows:

W. Oakbrook Circle at Sandy Court

The proposed project is a storm sewer improvement project including new curb and gutter, and storm sewer as needed. The project will be completed by City crews and is scheduled to start mid to late July 2013.

Street and Storm Sewer Improvements

The proposed street and storm sewer improvements include removing and replacing the existing concrete curb and gutter and installation of additional storm sewer to address ponding water and icing issues.

The City and the property owners adjoining the reconstruction will share the cost of the street improvements. The City shares the cost on a 50-50 basis with the property owners for removing and replacing the curb and gutter. The City assumes the entire cost for the new storm sewer improvements. The attached Schedule of Assessments shows a breakdown of costs for each street reconstruction item and the total estimated cost to be assessed to each adjacent property owner. Impact on Trees and Landscaping

Tree pruning, in advance of the project may be required to reduce the risk of damage to the trees during construction. The City of Madison-Forestry section will perform the necessary work prior to construction. During construction, it may be necessary to trim additional tree limbs and/or roots to accommodate the construction. Prior to the start of

construction, City Engineering will review the project with City Forestry to determine if any tree removals will be necessary. If a tree does need to be removed, the adjacent properties will be notified prior to its removal. During construction, additional tree conflicts are often encountered. If, during the course of construction, it is determined that a tree must be removed, City Engineering will notify property owners adjacent to the tree to be removed, prior to removal.

When the project is complete, City Forestry Section will evaluate the terrace area for new street trees or replacements. Street trees are typically planted in the spring of the year following the completion of the construction project. Tree species selection is determined by the City Forestry Section.

Please note that construction will also have an impact on existing flower gardens and other plantings within the terrace. With the nature of this work, property owners should anticipate that most of the terrace will be disturbed; therefore, any plantings or special landscaping features that an owner wishes to save from damage should be removed from the terrace area prior to the start of construction.

Special Assessments – General

A special assessment is a special charge for work that the City is planning to complete. The attached Schedule of Assessments shows an *estimate* of the property owners' share of the project costs based upon the City's assessment policy. After the project is bid, and work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of eight years, with 3% interest charged on the unpaid balance.


