Erdman said she is writing a Letter of Intent. A predesign meeting with Planning and Zoning will be held. Specific Implementation Plan (SIP) approval in January. Selecting a contractor. Wachter checking to see if we need an RFP.

5B 31304 Review Plat, Lot Prices, Affordability

Wachter said the gap has grown for people at 50% County Median Income (CMI). CDBG funding could be used. Erdman suggested using programs that already exist, such as the Down Payment Assistance program. She also mentioned non-profits. We need to get budget authority from Council to cover shortfalls. The sale of the houses will require the owner stay for 10 years to receive a forgivable loan from the CDA. Purchasers of the lots must use our builder, Kegonsa, and must comply with our design guidelines. One-third of the lots will be sold to people who make less than 50% CMI.
