LETTER OF INTENT

RE: PUD/GDP – temporary construction signage

Edgewater Hotel 666 Wisconsin Avenue Madison, Wisconsin

Dear Members of the Urban Design Commission:

This application is being submitted for Commission review and approval of a "temporary construction fence signage" and a "temporary banner sign." The proposed signage package will be in place only during the construction phase of the project.

Under the provisions of the Street Graphics Ordinance, a total of 144 square feet per street frontage is allowed. Since the PUD zoning on the property did not provide for the signage proposed, this application is being submitted for formal consideration as an amendment to the approved PUD by Commission. Details of the temporary construction sign package are provided on the following pages for review, noting the various types of signage to be displayed.

The proposed temporary construction fence signage includes a wrap that will improve the appearance of the site during construction. It will include attractive, project-related information, while protecting the neighborhood, pedestrians, and vehicular traffic from the construction site. The fence wrap will reflect an informational and design theme communicating the purpose of the project as well as noting the range of participants for the project.

This temporary construction fence signage will include all proposed temporary construction signage on the site other than safety and general contractor requirements and the proposed banner sign if approved. All together the surface area of the temporary construction fence signage equals approximately 2,152 square feet. There will be no other individual signage for the following:

- · Project information
- Real estate purposes
- Condo sales
- Lenders
- Contractors
- Subcontractors
- Marketing and advertising
- · Communication to the public

This temporary construction fence signage is a fairly new concept for the City of Madison. We appreciate the Commission taking the time to review and consider our application. The most relevant comparison for this concept is the temporary construction signage package for the Wisconsin Institute of Discovery (WID). We have included the WID application from April 2, 2008 for your convenience.



The surface area of the temporary banner signage is approximately 216 square feet.

Thank you for taking time to review our application.




Site Locator Map





Dear Members of the Urban Design Commission:

This submission is a continuation of the Planned Unit Development (PUD) Specific Implementation Plan (SIP) for the Wisconsin Institutes for Discovery. With this submission, we seek your approval of the proposed temporary signage for the project site.

The proposed sign package will be in place during the construction phase of the project. The proposed package includes a fence wrap, which will improve the appearance of the site during construction. The signage consists of wrap signage, which identifies the two institutes that will be housed on site, and two larger project signs – one at the corner of Campus Drive and Randall Avenue and the other at the corner of University Avenue and Orchard Street. All together, the surface area of the temporary signage equals approximately 460 square feet, and is spread over some 900 linear feet of frontage along four public streets.


