## **Standards for Variance**


The Zoning Board of Appeals shall not grant a variance unless it finds that the applicant has shown the following standards are met:

1. There are conditions unique to the property of the applicant that do not apply generally properties in the district.		
	Due to the placement of the existing house on an undersized lot,	
	a variance is unavoidable given the configuration of the house.	
2.	The variance is not contrary to the spirit, purpose, and intent of the regulations in the zoning district and is not contrary to the public interest.	
	This proposed design represents what we feel is an appropriate solution for the project that blends with the neighborhood and	
	Minimizes impact. The total volume requiring a variance is minimized	
3.	For an area (setbacks, etc) variance, compliance with the strict letter of the ordinance would unreasonably prevent use of the property for a permitted purpose or would render compliance with the ordinance unnecessarily burdensome.	
	As stated in the variance description, and as shown on the drawings, it would be very difficult to achieve use of the attic space.	
4.	The alleged difficulty or hardship is created by the terms of the ordinance rather than by a person who has a present interest in the property.	
	This is an older house, built way before we owned the house,	
5	The proposed variance shall not create substantial detriment to adjacent property.	
٥.	Because of the small amount of added volume in the setback	
	area, we feel it has minimal impact on neighboring property.	
6.	The proposed variance shall be compatible with the character of the immediate neighborhood.	
	We have designed the proposed work to achieve our goals with the minimum encroadnment into the setback and with rooflines that	
	are compatible with the neighborhood.
