2014 Public Health Grants and Contracts

Public Health-Madison and Dane County (PHMDC) has many grants and contracts whereby it receives funds to support public health services. The grants included in this resolution are continuations of grants from previous years; they were reviewed and approved by the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the City of Madison Common Council in previous funding cycles. Under the terms of the merger agreement, Public Health—Madison and Dane County may accept continuation grants with the approval of the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County (IGA, VIII, F, 1-3). These contracts represent about \$2,050,000 in revenue that is anticipated in the 2014 Adopted Operating Budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County authorizes the Director of Public Health, or his/her designee, to sign the following contracts and agreements that are anticipated in the 2014 Public Health Operating Budget:

- Consolidated Contract (Division of Public Health of the Wisconsin Department of Health Services) for childhood lead, radon outreach, immunization, maternal child health;
- HIV Prevention and Linkages to Care (Division of Public Health of the Wisconsin Department of Health Services) for counseling and partner referral services;
- Public Health Preparedness (Division of Public Health of the Wisconsin Department of Health Services) for emergency preparedness planning;
- Tobacco Prevention and Control (Division of Public Health of the Wisconsin Department of Health Services) for tobacco education and compliance checks;
- Prevention Block Grant (Division of Public Health of the Wisconsin Department of Health Services)
- Transient Non-Community Public Water Systems (Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources) to test private water systems;
- Treatment Access Fund (Susan G. Komen for the Cure, South Central Wisconsin) for breast and cervical cancer screening and support services;
- Tuberculosis (TB) Dispensary (Division of Public Health of the Wisconsin Department of Health Services) to reimburse local providers for TB services when clients have no health coverage;
- Well Woman Program (Division of Public Health of the Wisconsin Department of Health Service) to promote breast and cervical cancer screening among women with no health coverage;
- West Nile Virus Partner Agreements (local municipalities and governmental agencies) for mosquito surveillance and control;
- Wisconsin Fund (Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources) for the replacement of septic systems;

- WIC Program (Division of Public Health of the Wisconsin Department of Health Service) to safeguard the health of low-income women, infants, and children up to age five who are at nutritional risk by nutritious food to supplement diets, information on healthy eating, and referrals to health care;
- Agent Agreement for Retail Food Establishment Licensing (Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection) to administer a retail food establishment licensing program;
- Agent Agreement for the Inspection of Manufactured Homes (Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services) to inspect each manufactured home community in Dane County for the enforcement of state sanitary regulations; and
- Transient Non-Community Program (Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources) for collecting and testing water samples and evaluating the well for transient, non-community water systems (private water systems maintained by commercial establishments, churches, parks, campgrounds).
- Agent Agreement (Wisconsin Department of Health Services) to issue permits, inspect and regulate restaurants, campgrounds, recreational educational camps, public swimming pools, hotels, motels, tourist rooming houses and bed and breakfast establishments, and inspect vending machines.
