#### Dear Amy,

This letter is to serve at the Notice of Intent regarding a recent project on Edgewood College Campus. The purpose of the project was to gain access to the communication box mounted in the sidewalk right on the north side of the Park & Pleasure Drive. See the following attachments for work site location (Attachment A), project routing plan (Attachment B), and project layout on master plan (Attachment C). At that point, we were not aware that there was a mound or protected area in that location. We were working off the Master Plan, which we assumed to be correct. As you can see in the letter provided by Doug Hursh (Potter Lawson), the map we were working from was not accurate (Attachment D & E).

The project work commenced on November 27<sup>th</sup>. I received a call from Professor Jim Lorman in the early afternoon to alert me that there was a mound in that area. At that point, I talked with the contractors (J&R Underground) who were instructed that no additional work was to take place. Professor Lorman contacted Leslie Eisenberg, who came out to campus to review what had taken place. I also returned to campus to meet with Ms. Eisenberg. She confirmed that all work would be ceased, and she also contacted Phil Salkin, who is the archeologist we have worked with in the past. I also had contacted Phil, who was out of town until December 4<sup>th</sup>.

Ms. Eisenberg expressed that this needed to be addressed in a timely fashion, and since we did not hear back from Phil, we contacted Robert Birmingham. We also contracted with JSD Professional Services, Inc. to perform the required survey work. On December 5<sup>th</sup>, Tim Fargo, our Building and Grounds Coordinator, and I met with Robert Birmingham and JSD to discuss the work that needed to be done. Leslie had requested the following to occur:

- Get a surveyor to re-flag the original legal boundary for the mound.
- At same time, map the current disturbance.
- Shoot the angle at the disturbance.
- Screen loose dirt outside hole and determine what had been previously disturbed.

At this point, the survey work is complete and Mr. Birmingham is finishing his work and preparing a report that will be submitted to Ms. Eisenberg.

Once we receive the report, we will understand how to best gain access to the communications box.

In order to prevent a situation like this again, Tim Fargo and I will be meeting with Ms. Eisenberg to understand the campus grounds, including all mounds and protected areas. We will also discuss the proper processes and procedures for any invasive work as well as best practices for mound care and maintenance.

We apologize if our work has unintentionally affected the protected area.






