In reviewing with Lori Zenchenko of our office, the 1000 address will not work as outlined below:

1) The address of the Edgewater is 666 Wisconsin Ave. The new tower is 661 Wisconsin Ave. It has been shared that all access will be gained thru the new tower.

The new tower is located on the north side of the street (odd numbered side).

- 2) 1001 Wisconsin PI would be allowed due to the unique situation/street configuration and the maintenance agreements that the hotel covers.
- 3) The entrance is on the odd side of the street. The suggestion of 1000 will not work. In addition, 1000 would not be allowed as mentioned before as 00's and 000's represent blocks of property, not a specific location. No new addresses are allowed to use hundred/thousand block designations.
- 4) The address number change is a separate issue and can be handled simultaneously with the street name change. The numbering can be handled outside of the resolution for the street name change.
