 This project will disturb over an acre at each location, which will require three separate Notice of Intent permits from the WDNR and a City Engineering Erosi
 - separate Notice of Intent permits from the WDNR and a City Engineering Erosion Control Permit. (Eric Dundee, City Engineering)
- 6. Oakridge/Ohio/Miller Ave Resurfacing
 This project is under an acre, but will require a City Engineering Erosion Control
 Permit, as well as other DNR, DSPS, and DHS permits. (LeAnne Hannan, City
 Engineering)
- 25. MPD Training Center Parking Lot Expansion Landscaping
 This project disturbs under an acre of land. It does not require a DNR permit, but
 does require a City Erosion Control Permit. (Randy Wiesner, City Engineering)
- 27. Cannonball Path Phase 5

 This project requires a Notice of Intent, Chapter 30 permit and wetland disturbance permit from the DNR. Wetland impacts also require approval from Army Corps of Engineers. (Tony Fernandez, City Engineering)
