Dear Mr. Pynnonen;

The one-lot certified survey of property located at 2029-2037 S. Park Street and 2032 Taft Street, Section 35, Township 7N, Range 9E, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, is hereby **conditionally approved**. The site was recently rezoned TR-V2 (Traditional Residential–Varied 2 District) for a residential building complex. The conditions of approval from the reviewing agencies to be satisfied before final approval and recording of the CSM are:

- 1. Change the prepared for party on sheet 1. It the named party does not match Madison Development Corp. as noted on all other sheets.
- 2. Add Section 35 to the Certified Survey Map (CSM) header and the legal description under the Surveyor's Certificate.
- 3. The recorded as data for the west line of the CSM shall be changed to N 02°39′ W, not N 0°39′ W.
- 4. Add adjoiner information (plat, lots and block) to the properties to the south and east of this CSM.
- 5. Legal description is missing distance on first call after point of beginning (add distance of 117.10 feet).
- 6. Legal description and map show street as Park Street. Update the spelling of the street name to <u>S.</u> Park Street.
- 7. Each building shall have a separate sanitary sewer lateral.

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- 8. The applicant shall dedicate right of way along S. Park Street and Beld Street to match the existing terrace width on Beld Street to the north (14 feet from back of curb to the property line).
- 9. A minimum of 2 working days prior to requesting City Engineering Division signoff on the CSM, the applicant shall contact Janet Dailey (261-9688) to obtain the final stormwater utility charges that are due and payable prior to sub-division of the properties. The stormwater utility charges (as all utility charges) are due for the previous months of service. All charges shall be cleared prior to the land division (and subsequent obsolesces of the existing parcel).
- 10. All outstanding Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) charges are due and payable prior to City Engineering Division sign-off, unless otherwise collected with a Developer's / Subdivision Contract. Contact Janet Dailey (261-9688) to obtain the final MMSD billing a minimum of 2 working days prior to requesting City Engineering Division signoff.
- 11. Prior to approval, the owner or owner's representative shall obtain a permit to plug each existing sanitary and/ or storm sewer lateral that serves a building which is proposed for demolition. For each lateral to be plugged the owner shall complete a sewer lateral plugging application and pay the applicable permit fees. Note: As of January 1, 2013, new plugging procedures and permit fees are in effect.
- 12. Wisconsin Administrative Code A-E 7.08 identifies when Public Land System (PLS) tie sheets must be filed with the Dane County Surveyor's office. The developer's surveyor and/or applicant must submit copies of required tie sheets or condition reports for all monuments, including center of sections of record, used in this survey, to Eric Pederson, City Engineering Division. If a new tie sheet is not required under A-E 7.08, Engineering requests a copy of the latest tie sheet on record with Dane County Surveyor's office. The applicant shall identify monument types on all PLS corners included on the plat or CSM. Note: Land tie to two PLS corners required.
- 13. Per MGO 16.23(5)(g)(2)City of Madison Environmental Projects Staff have reviewed the subject site and determined that a Phase I ESA will be required of the applicant. The applicant shall provide 1 digital and 2 hard copies of an ASTM Phase I ESA prepared by an environmental professional. Staff review of this Phase I ESA will determine if a further investigative Phase II ESA is also required. Please submit any relevant Phase I and Phase II ESAs to Brynn Bemis (267-1986, bbemis@cityofmadison.com) for further review.

Please contact Dennis Cawley of the Madison Water Utility at 261-9243 if you have any questions regarding the following two (2) items:

- 14. Lands in this CSM are located in City of Madison Wellhead Protection District WP-18. The proposed use is allowed in this district. Any proposed changes in use shall be approved by the Water Utility General Manager or his designee.
- 15. Note: Per MGO Section 13.21, all wells located on this property shall be abandoned if no valid well operation permit has been obtained from the Madison Water Utility.

16. The following note shall be added to the CSM: "Lots/ buildings within this subdivision/ development are subject to impact fees that are due and payable at the time building permit(s) are issued."

Please contact Jenny Frese of the Office of Real Estate Services at 267-8719 if you have any questions regarding the following five (5) items:

- 17. Prior to requesting approval sign-off of the CSM, executed signature block certifications shall be included for all parties of interest, pursuant to MGO Section 16.23(5)(g)4 and Wis. Stats. Section 236.21(2)(a). All signatory parties shall provide documentation that proves said signatories have legal authority to sign the Owner's Certificate. The title of each certificate shall be consistent with the ownership interest reported in the most recent title report.
- 18. A certificate of consent by all mortgagees/vendors shall be included following the Owner(s) Certificate and executed prior to final sign-off.
- 19. Per Under 236.21(3) Wis. Stats. and MGO Section 16.23(5)(g), the property owner shall pay all real estate taxes and special assessments for the subject property prior to CSM recording. Please provide staff with proof of payment prior to final signoff and recording of the CSM. [Note: As of January 21, 2014, there are no special assessments reported for the parcels within the CSM.]
- 20. Please verify that stormwater management charges are paid in full by contacting Janet Dailey with City Engineering (261-9688) or Sharon Pounders with the Madison Water Utility (266-4641).
- 21. The following CSM revisions shall be made: Create and record, or show as being dedicated in the proposed CSM, easements for utility and drainage rights of way when the utility or drainage physically exists, but no document for it exists in record title.

The demolition permit and conditional use plans for the related townhouse development shall receive final staff approval and be stamped by the Zoning Administrator <u>prior</u> to the final approval and recording of this CSM. Please contact my office at 261-9632 if you have questions about this requirement.

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency.

A resolution approving the CSM and authorizing the City to sign it and any other documents related to the proposed land division was approved by the Common Council on <u>February 4</u>, <u>2014</u>.

As soon as the comments and conditions have been satisfied as verified with a completed affidavit form (attached), the original along with the revised Certified Survey Map, with all signatures and approvals from the reviewing agencies, shall be brought to this office for final signoff. You or your client may then record the certified survey at the Dane County Register of Deeds. For information on recording procedures and fees, contact the Register of Deeds at 266-4141.

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Prior to City Engineering final sign-off by the main office of the CSM, the final CSM shall be submitted to the Engineering Division Surveyor/ Land Records Coordinator for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two working days prior to final Engineering Division signoff. Email submittal of the final CSM in PDF form is preferred. Transmit to jrquamme@cityofmadison.com.

The owner shall furnish to the Office of Real Estate Services and the survey firm preparing the CSM an updated title report covering the period between the date of the initial title report and the date when final signoff is requested. The surveyor shall update the CSM with the most recent information reported in the title update.

Upon acceptance and recording of the Certified Survey Map by the Dane County Register of Deeds, please transfer the recorded volume, document number, and page numbers to the copies and forward a copy to this office for our records. The original survey map with the recording information is permanently kept on file in the Dane County Register of Deeds Office. A copy of the recorded document can be obtained from the Register of Deeds Office, Room 110, City-County Building or the Real Estate Office in the Madison Department of Planning and Development.

Any appeal from this action, including the conditions of approval, must be filed with the Circuit Court within 30 days from the date of this letter. The approval of this CSM shall be null and void if not recorded in six (6) months from the date of the approving resolution or this letter, whichever is later.
