Fact and Details Sheet Proposed 2014 Langdon Street Streetscape Improvement Project

Project Details - Proposed Work

Street Lights: The existing pedestrian lights on the north side of Langdon St. will be replaced and new pedestrian lights will be installed on the south side (*assessable*). The style of the pedestrian lights will match the lights on Langdon St. west of Frances St. The existing tall street lights along Langdon will remain.

Street, Sidewalk & Terrace: Sidewalk and driveway aprons will be removed and replaced as necessary to repair damaged or unsafe (tripping hazards) sections or as necessary for the installation of the new pedestrian lights (*assessable*).

The existing pavers in the terrace have settled and become uneven, and areas that used to be grass have become worn and eroded. The City is proposing to remove the existing pavers and grass within the project limits and replace it with exposed aggregate concrete (assessable), which would match the portion of Langdon St. west of Frances St.

Some of the curb and gutter will also be replaced as necessary to repair damaged sections (assessable).

Due to snow cover, some quantities for curb and sidewalk on the enclosed schedule of assessments had to be assumed. The final assessments will be calculated based on the actual quantities installed as measured in the field.

Trees: There are 3 trees within the limits of this project that are planned for removal; these trees are at the following addresses: 216 Langdon St., 245 Langdon St. and 251 Langdon St. If possible, these sites will be replanted following the project. Gaps in the new concrete terrace will be provided for the trees that are to remain. During construction, if it is determined that any additional trees must be removed, the adjacent properties will be notified prior to the removal. All trees within the project limits will be pruned by City Forestry prior to the start of construction.

The site will also be reviewed to determine if any new trees can be planted, and openings in the exposed aggregate concrete terrace will be left for any new tree planting locations.

Construction Schedule & Impacts

Tentative Construction Schedule: start May 19, 2014 until Mid August, 2014

The project on Langdon St. is being bid under a single contract with projects on N. Henry St., W. Johnson St. and N. Hamilton St. The above dates refer to the total contract duration, but approximately (4 - 5 weeks) will be spent on Langdon St. It is expected that work on the contract will start on N. Henry St. and W. Johnson St. and then move to Langdon St.

Traffic Impacts: Langdon St. will remain to traffic within the project limits, but parking on the street will likely be removed to allow space for the contractor to work. Access will be maintained to all properties within the project limits.

Refuse Collection: It will be the contractor's responsibility to allow for refuse collection during construction. Please mark your address on your cart to make sure it is returned if moved. Please contact private collection companies to inform them of the project.
