Project Limits: N. Hamilton St. from E. Mifflin St. (Capitol Square) to N. Webster St. (Outer Looper), east side only

Proposed Project: Streetscape improvements including tree grates and new plantings

Existing Conditions:

- Existing Trees were planted in "tree pits" (opening in sidewalk, topped with mulch), see photo below
- Tree pits have effectively narrowed the sidewalk due to limited concrete width & drop off at edge of sidewalk
- Sidewalk width is too narrow for City Mall Maintenance to clear snow without gouging tree planting area
- Proposed Improvements:
 - Remove tree pits and install concrete sidewalk
 - Install new 4'x8' tree grates

Trees:

- All existing trees will need to be removed in order to install sidewalk and grates evenly with existing sidewalk
- New trees will be planted, in the same locations as the existing trees, following the project

Assessment Policy:

- Adjacent property owners & City share sidewalk costs 50/50
- City pays remaining costs for tree grates and tree removal/replacement
- Project Costs: Total Cost: \$55,000 Assessments: \$4,250 City Cost: \$50,750
- Schedule:Hamilton St. project is to be bid in contract with Langdon St. & Johnson/HenryAll work will be completed during summer 2014, construction on Hamilton to take approx 1 week
