- Improved bike/pedestrian crossings

West Gateway Intersection

- Improved bike/pedestrian crossings and facilities
- Improved wayfinding and visibility

Path Enhancements

- Maintain one-way auto traffic
- New eastbound contra-flow bike lane, less on-street parking
- Enhanced streetscapes
