Re:	Proposed 2015-2016 Community Development Program Goals & Objectives- Final

At the March 6th meeting of the Community Development Block Grant Committee, Community Development staff presented the Committee with a preliminary draft of the 2015-16 Community Development Program Goals and Objectives. Committee members briefly discussed the draft and offered some initial feedback to staff. Since that date, the following has occurred:

- Staff met with interested individuals and organizations, including members of the Third Sector, a group of non-profit affordable housing developers, and with Howard Mandeville from Movin' Out, Inc. to discuss the proposed draft.
- Community Development staff received public comments before the March 20th public hearing.
- On March 20th, the Committee held a public hearing on the preliminary draft during which verbal and written comments were offered by a handful of interested parties.
- Community Development staff met to review and discuss the comments and feedback received from the various sources and, in response, proposed some modifications to the preliminary draft. Staff also proposed a small number of other changes intended to clarify the intent of provisions in the document.

A revised 2015-16 Goals and Objectives document is attached for your review and consideration. It contains all of the staff-recommended changes to the preliminary draft, which are indicated through track changes. The CDBG Committee is scheduled to discuss the revised document at its next meeting, scheduled for April 3rd, and make final recommendations to the Common Council.
