
Planting Bed East of Towers

• City staff to install and maintain sod throughout the majority of the planting bed.

• City staff to install pockets of annual flowers in several areas of the bed to provide season-long color.


• City staff to maintain flowers throughout season (ie. weeding, watering and deadheading).




Planters on 500 and 600 Block near Towers and Potbelly







- For the 2014 season, install eight-42" Senora pots as illustrated.
 - o Four planters are currently kept in storage and have yet to be used.
 - o Four planters would be moved from low-impact areas
- Plant pots same as all other pots on the Mall/Concourse.
- Allow any surviving perennials in planters to grow and fill in gaps with annuals. Plants damaged by pedestrian traffic throughout the season will not be replaced.
- Contractor and City staff to maintain pots as part of BID program
- Plantings at the base of the pots within the planters will be maintained by City staff throughout the season.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of this layout throughout the season.
- If successful, choose and order permanent pots for these areas for 2015 season and beyond.



Planters on 500 and 600 Block near Towers and Potbelly

Planter at Monday's

- Remove excess soil.
- Edge bed to hold in mulch.
- Mulch bed with shredded mulch.
- Maintain bed throughout season (ie. weeding, raking, etc).



Planter at State Street Brats

- Mulch planter with shredded mulch.
- Maintain existing perennials.



Planters at East Main Street and King Street

- Mulch planters with shredded mulch.

 Maintain planters throughout season (ie. weeding, pruning as appropriate).







Planters at Overature Center

- Install additional perennials as necessary to fill voids.
- City staff to mulch planters with Olbrich leaf mulch.
- Maintain planters throughout season (ie. weeding, deadheading, monitoring/adjusting irrigation)
