Dear Mr. Phillips:

I represent Scott Construction, Inc., with respect to the above-referenced appeals. Enclosed please find copies of my client's February 27, 2014 Appeals that were received by your office yesterday. Please address all further correspondence and inquiries to me.

As you know, Scott Construction was awarded this very same work in both 2012 and 2013. Once again, Scott Construction was the low bidder for this work in 2014, by a combined total of almost \$175,000. However, this year, Scott Construction has been deemed a "non-responsible bidder" for allegedly failing to meet certain requirements related to the Small Business Enterprise ("SBE") Program. As a self-performing contractor, Scott Construction was not obligated to subcontract any portion of its work, thereby making the SBE-related goals not applicable to its bid. The City has agreed with this approach the last two years, as it awarded the 2012 and 2013 contracts when Scott Construction's bids **contained the identical SBE-related paperwork** as submitted in 2014. The City's decision to ignore this precedent, and ignore the plain language of its own SBE Program, is arbitrary, capricious and in violation of the law.

As a result, Scott Construction respectively requests that the two February 26, 2014 decisions finding Scott Construction to be a non-responsible bidder be rescinded immediately, and Scott Construction awarded both contracts as the lowest, responsible bidder.

I am going to be out of the state for most of the next week, returning to the office on Friday, March 7, 2014. As such, I would request that no proceedings are scheduled on this matter during that time. I
