## **SUMMARY:**

At its meeting of May 7, 2014, the Urban Design Commission **GRANTED FINAL APPROVAL** of a PD(SIP) façade modifications located at 1924 Atwood Avenue. Appearing on behalf of the project were Randy Bruce and Scott Lewis. Bruce noted changes to the plans including elimination of the dark coping at the top of the brick, a metal piece has been brought up and over the brick, and they used a mix of materials that they had selected originally, using fiber cement siding instead of metal. The windows will be dark in color. Some of the angles will be kept along the bays and across the back where it meets the angled property line.
