Dear Mr. Spetz;

The two-lot certified survey of property located at 2007-2011 Van Hise Avenue, Section 22, Township 7N, Range 9E, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, was **conditionally approved** by the Plan Commission at its June 9, 2014 meeting. The conditions of approval from the reviewing agencies to be satisfied prior to final approval and recording of the CSM are:

Please contact Janet Schmidt of the City Engineering Division at 261-9688 if you have questions regarding the following eight (8) items:

- 1. Capitalize the word "block" on the third to last line of the legal description under the Surveyor's Certificate.
- 2. Clarify the overall distances shown on the north and south lines of Lot 1 are not between the two nearest monuments.
- 3. As proposed, the lot to be developed will drain directly into the middle of the home to the south. The applicant for a building permit shall be required to provide a detailed drainage plan to the City Engineer for approval prior to being issued a building permit.
- 4. Add the following note to the CSM: "At the time of development of Lot 2, the applicant shall provide a detailed drainage plan for approval to City Engineering showing how downstream properties are protected from additional runoff."
- 5. Lot 2 shall install a new sanitary sewer and water lateral to serve proposed development. This requirement shall be noted on the CSM.
- 6. A minimum of 2 working days prior to requesting City Engineering signoff on the plat, the applicant shall contact Janet Schmidt (261-9688) to obtain the final stormwater utility charges that are due and payable prior to subdivision of the properties. The stormwater utility charges (as all utility

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charges) are due for the previous months of service. All charges shall be cleared prior to the land division (and subsequent obsolesces of the existing parcel).

- 7. All outstanding Madison Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) and City of Madison sanitary sewer connection charges are due and payable prior to City Engineering Division sign-off, unless otherwise collected with a Developer's/ Subdivision Contract. Contact Janet Schmidt (261-9688) to obtain the final MMSD billing a minimum of 2 working days prior to requesting City Engineering signoff.
- 8. Wisconsin Administrative Code A-E 7.08 identifies when Public Land System (PLS) tie sheets must be filed with the Dane County Surveyor's office. The Developer's Surveyor and/or Applicant must submit copies of required tie sheets or condition reports for all monuments, including center of sections of record, used in this survey, to Eric Pederson, City Engineering. If a new tie sheet is not required under A-E 7.08, Engineering requests a copy of the latest tie sheet on record with Dane County Surveyor's office. The applicant shall identify monument types on all PLS corners included on the Plat. Note: Land tie to two PLS corners required.

Please contact Dennis Cawley of the Madison Water Utility at 261-9243 if you have any questions regarding the following item:

9. Note: All unused private wells shall be abandoned in accordance with MGO Sec. 13.21.

Please contact Kay Rutledge of the Parks Division at 266-4714 if you have any questions regarding the following two (2) items:

- 10. Park impact fees (comprised of the Park Development Impact Fee per MGO Sec. 20.08(2) and the Parkland Impact Fee in lieu of land dedication per MGO Sec. 16.23(8)(f) and 20.08(6)) may be required for all new residential development. This development is within the Vilas-Brittingham park impact fee district (SI27). Please reference ID#14127 when contacting Parks Division staff about this project.
- 11. Approval of plans for this project does not include any approval to prune, remove or plant trees in the public right of way. Permission for such activities must be obtained from the City Forester, 266-4816.

Please contact Pat Anderson, Assistant Zoning Administrator, at 266-5978 if you have any questions regarding the following item:

12. The gazebo on proposed Lot 2 shall be removed prior to final approval and recording; the Zoning Code does not allow accessory buildings on lots without principal buildings.

Please contact Jenny Frese of the Office of Real Estate Services at 267-8719 if you have any questions regarding the following four (4) items:

13. Prior to requesting final sign-off, executed signature block certifications shall be included for all parties of interest, pursuant to Wis. Stats. 236.21(2)(a). The title of each certificate shall be consistent with the ownership interest reported in the most recent title report.

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- 14. A certificate of consent for all mortgagees/vendors shall be included following the Owner's Certificate(s) and executed prior to final CSM sign-off.
- 15. Under 236.21(3) Wis. Stats. and MGO Section 16.23(5)(g)(1), the property owner shall pay all real estate taxes and special assessments that are accrued or delinquent for the subject property prior to CSM recording. As of May 10, 2014, the 2013 real estate taxes are paid for the subject property and there are no special assessments reported.
- 16. Prior to final CSM sign-off, please verify with Janet Schmidt of the City Engineering Division (261-9688) or Sharon Pounders at the Water Utility (266-4641) that stormwater management fees are paid in full.

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency.

A resolution approving the CSM and authorizing the City to sign it and any other documents related to the proposed land division is scheduled for review by the Common Council on June 17, 2014.

Note: The Madison Fire Department supported the lot adjustment to improve fire separation distance from the existing structure.

As soon as the comments and conditions have been satisfied as verified with a completed affidavit form (attached), the original along with the revised Certified Survey Map, with all signatures and approvals from the reviewing agencies, shall be brought to this office for final signoff. You or your client may then record the certified survey at the Dane County Register of Deeds. For information on recording procedures and fees, contact the Register of Deeds at 266-4141.

Prior to City Engineering final sign-off by the main office of the CSM, the final CSM shall be submitted to the Engineering Division Surveyor/ Land Records Coordinator for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two working days prior to final Engineering Division signoff. Email submittal of the final CSM in PDF form is preferred. Transmit to jrquamme@cityofmadison.com.

The owner shall furnish to the Office of Real Estate Services and the survey firm preparing the CSM an updated title report covering the period between the date of the initial title report and the date when final signoff is requested. The surveyor shall update the CSM with the most recent information reported in the title update.

Upon acceptance and recording of the Certified Survey Map by the Dane County Register of Deeds, please transfer the recorded volume, document number, and page numbers to the copies and forward a copy to this office for our records. The original survey map with the recording information is permanently kept on file in the Dane County Register of Deeds Office. A copy of the recorded document can be obtained from the Register of Deeds Office, Room 110, City-County Building or the Real Estate Office in the Madison Department of Planning and Development.

Any appeal from this action, including the conditions of approval, must be filed with the Circuit Court within 30 days from the date of this letter. The approval of this CSM shall be null and void if not

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recorded in twelve (12) months from the date of the approving resolution or this letter, whichever is later.
