RE: Approval of a conditional use for a cheerleading instruction facility (an arts, technical, or trade school) at 4009 Felland Road.

Dear Mr. Atkielski:

At its June 23, 2014 meeting, the Plan Commission found the standards met and **approved** your client's request for a conditional use at 4009 Felland Road, subject to the conditions below. In order to receive final approval of the conditional use, and for any necessary permits to be issued for your project, the following conditions shall be met:

- 1. The warehouse/office/miscellaneous suites of 110, 111, 132, and 133 have been combined into Suite 112. Part of Suite 112 has been reconfigured and is now part of Suite 131. The addresses of 4009 Felland Road, Suite 110, 111, 132, and 133 have been inactivated.
- 2. The applicant shall submit, prior to plan sign-off, digital PDF files to the Engineering Division (Jeff Benedict or Tim Troester). The digital copies shall be to scale, and shall have a scale bar on the plan set (POLICY and MGO 37.09(2)).

PDF submittals shall contain the following information:

- a) Building footprints
- b) Internal walkway areas
- c) Internal site parking areas
- d) Lot lines and right-of-way lines
- e) Street names
- f) Stormwater Management Facilities
- g) Detail drawings associated with Stormwater Mgmt Facilities (including if applicable planting plans)

Please contact Pat Anderson of the Zoning Office at 266-5978 if you have any questions regarding the following item:

3. Bike parking shall comply with City of Madison General Ordinances Table 28I-3 (General Regulations). Provide five bike parking stalls for said uses. Bicycle parking design and location shall comply with MGO Sec. 28.141 (11). Provide detail of bike rack on final plans, a bike parking stall is two feet by six feet with a five-foot access area.

Please contact Eric Halvorson of Traffic Engineering at 266-6527 if you have any questions regarding the following 4 items:

- 4. The applicant shall submit one contiguous plan for approval. The plan drawing shall be scaled to 1" = 20' and include the following, when applicable: existing and proposed property lines; parcel addresses; all easements; pavement markings; signing; building placement; items in the terrace such as signs, street light poles, hydrants; surface types such as asphalt, concrete, grass, sidewalk; driveway approaches, including those adjacent to and across street from the project lot location; parking stall dimensions, including two (2) feet of vehicle overhang; drive aisle dimensions; semitrailer movement and vehicle routes; dimensions of radii; and percent of slope.
- 5. The Developer shall post a security deposit prior to the start of development. In the event that modifications need to be made to any City owned and/or maintained traffic signals, street lighting, signing, pavement marking and conduit/handholes, the Developer shall reimburse the City for all associated costs including engineering, labor and materials for both temporary and permanent installations.
- 6. The City Traffic Engineer may require public signing and marking related to the development; the Developer shall be financially responsible for such signing and marking.
- 7. All parking facility design shall conform to MGO standards, as set in section 10.08(6).

8. The Madison Fire Department does not object to this proposal provided the project complies with all applicable fire codes and ordinances.

Please contact Dennis Cawley of the Water Utility at 266-4651 if you have any questions about the following item:

9. All wells located on this property shall be abandoned if no valid well operation permit has been obtained from the Madison Water Utility.

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency. No demolition or building permits shall be issued until the applicant has met all of the conditions of approval stated in this letter.

Please now follow the procedures listed below for obtaining your building permits:

- 1. Please revise the plans per the above conditions and file **eight (8)** sets of complete, fully dimensioned, and to-scale plans, along with the appropriate site plan review application and fee pursuant to Section 28.206 of the Zoning Code. Also provide any other documentation requested herein with the Zoning Administrator, Room LL-100, Madison Municipal Building, 215 Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard.
- 2. This letter shall be signed by the applicant to acknowledge the conditions of approval and returned to the Zoning Administrator when requesting building permit approval.
- 3. No alteration of this proposal shall be permitted unless approved by the Plan Commission, provided, however, the Zoning Administrator may issue permits for minor alterations. This approval shall become null and void one year after the date of the Plan Commission unless the use is commenced, construction is under way, or a valid building permit is issued and construction commenced within six months of the issuance of said building permit.
