Hasselman clarified the concerns noted in the staff report including the locations of the cornice and gutter, window infill configuration, the railing design, the appearance of the light fixtures with a modern industrial aesthetic, the stair door in painted steel, the stair tower door, an apartment door, and the concrete retaining walls.

Hasselman explained that the tiled infill wall areas would be removed and the glass wall systems would be installed in an attempt to return the building to a more historically appropriate appearance.
