WHEREAS, the CDA is in support of the elimination of blight and the redevelopment of distressed affordable housing in the City of Madison;

WHEREAS, an application by Mirus Partners, Inc. has been made for the acquisition and rehab of 127 housing units formerly known as "The Woodlands;"

WHEREAS, the project is in serious need of capital improvements and professional management, and has become a significant strain on the City of Madison resources via building inspection, legal and safety needs;

WHEREAS, Mirus Partners, Inc. has requested that CDA provide eight (8) project-based vouchers to keep the units affordable;

WHEREAS, the CDA has determined that including eight (8) project-based vouchers is necessary to make the project successful and to keep rents affordable;

WHEREAS, the City of Madison Community Development Authority (CDA) has established a Project-Based Voucher program to further the overall housing strategy;

WHEREAS, the development has already been awarded federal, state or local funds through a competitive process and so CDA is not subject to any requirement to conduct a separate competitive process to award project-based vouchers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the CDA is hereby authorizing the Executive Director to enter into a contract with Mirus Partners, Inc. to provide eight (8) Project-Based Vouchers to Northridge Terrace (formerly "The Woodlands").

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
