At its September 22, 2014 meeting, the Plan Commission found the standards met and **approved** your conditional use alteration for 9306-9414 Silicon Prairie Parkway and 9315 Fortunate Place subject to the conditions of approval in the following sections, which shall be satisfied prior to issuance of building permits for the project.

1. It is understood that this conditional use approval is for façade changes only. The applicant shall comply with the conditions of approval from the January 14, 2014 Planning Division approval letter and with the previously approved site, utility, erosion and grading plans and permits on file.

2. The revised site plan showing the relocated bike rack shall be reflected on the approved landscape plan.

3. Note: All operating private wells shall be identified and permitted and any unused private wells shall be abandoned by the Madison Water Utility in accordance with MGO Section 13.21.

- 4. Per the previous approval of this project, park impact fees (comprised of the Park Development Impact Fee per MGO Sec. 20.08(2) and the Parkland Impact Fee in lieu of land dedication per MGO Sec. 16.23(8)(f) and 20.08(6)) will be required for all new residential development in this development. This development is within the Elver Park impact fee district (SI31). Please reference ID# 13137 when contacting Parks Division staff about this project.
- 5. Approval of plans for this for this project does not include any approval to prune, remove or plant trees in the public right-of-way. Permission for such activities must be obtained from the City Forester, 266-4816.

Please contact my office at 261-9632 if you have any questions about the following item:

6. Revise the development plans prior to final staff approval and the issuance of building permits as follows to revise Sheet 21 to correctly label the elevations by elevation (north, south).

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency.

Please now follow the procedures listed below for obtaining permits for your project:

- 1. After the plans have been revised per the above conditions, please file **nine (9) sets** of complete, fully dimensioned, and to-scale plans, the appropriate site plan review application and fee pursuant to Section 28.206 of the Zoning Code, and any other documentation requested herein with the Zoning Administrator, Room LL-100, Madison Municipal Building, 215 Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard. The sets of final revised plans or documents will be circulated by Zoning staff to the City department staff listed above for their final approval. [Note: You may already have an application for these alterations pending with Zoning and should discuss the procedures for this resubmittal with them prior to filing.]
- 2. This letter shall be signed by the applicant and property owner (if not the applicant) to acknowledge the conditions of approval and returned to the Zoning Administrator when requesting building permit approval.
- 3. No alteration of this proposal shall be permitted unless approved by the Plan Commission, provided, however, the Zoning Administrator may issue permits for minor alterations. No alteration of a conditional use shall be permitted unless approved by the Plan Commission provided, however, the Zoning Administrator following consideration by the alderperson of the district, may approve minor alterations or additions which are approved by the Director of Planning and Community and Economic Development and are compatible with the concept approved by the Plan Commission and the conditional use standards. This approval shall become null and void one (1) year after the date of the Plan Commission unless the use is commenced, construction is under way, or a valid building permit is issued and construction commenced within 6 months of the issuance of said building permit. Where the plans have not been altered from the Plan Commission's approval, and the conditional use has expired, the Director of Planning and Community and Economic Development may, after consultation with the Alderperson of the District, approve an extension for up to 24

months from the expiration date. The Plan Commission shall retain jurisdiction over this matter for the purpose of resolving complaints against the approved conditional use permit.
