## **BUS RAPID TRANSIT**

The Madison Area Transportation Planning Board – A Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has finished the Transit Corridor Study to develop and evaluate system-level and corridor-level concept plans for bus rapid transit (BRT) along four primary transit corridors in the Madison area.

BRT is a frequent, high-capacity, limited-stop transit service that offers improved rider experience on busy travel corridors. It offers many similar advantages to rail transit, including reduced travel times, high capacity, operational efficiencies, attraction of new transit riders, and enhanced image.
