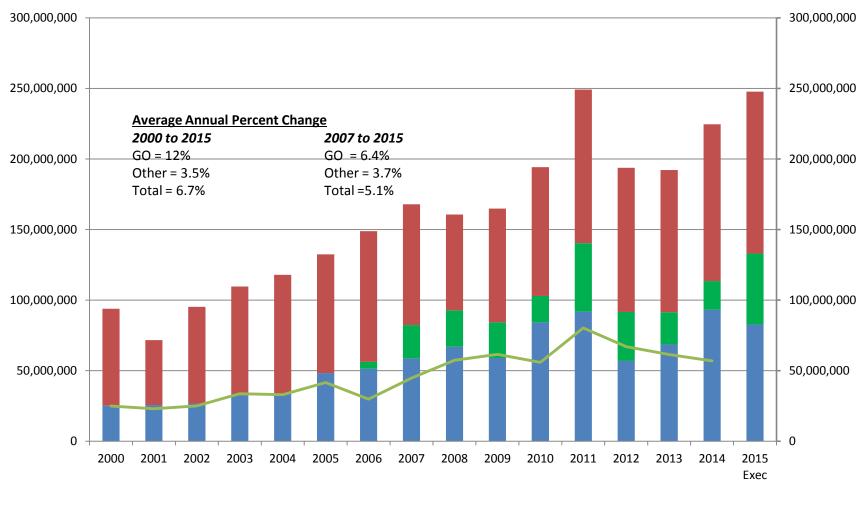

2014 Borrowing

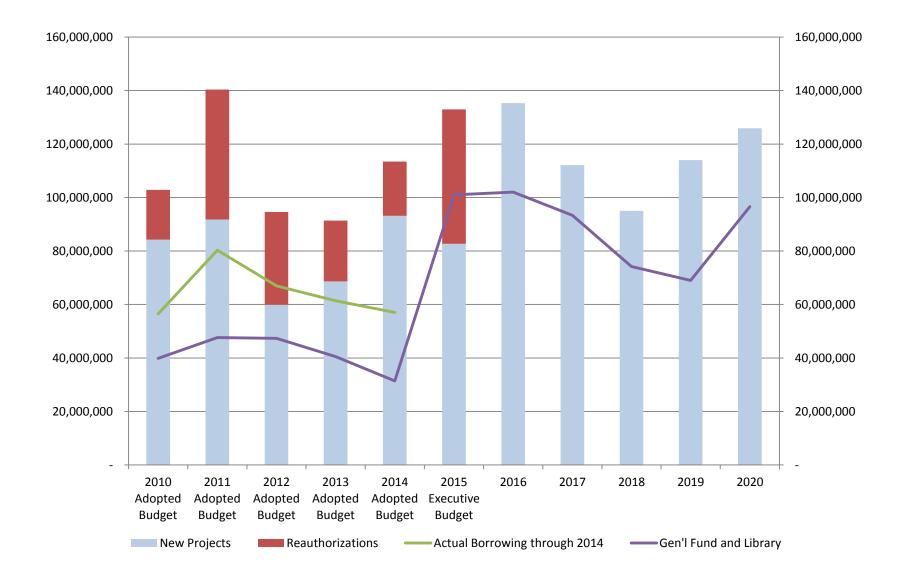
- Final = \$56.9 million
 - \$5.3 million taxable (TID 36 = \$4.4m)
 - \$50.2 million reauthorized; \$10 million cancelled
 - \$2 million for Special Assessment Fund
 - Total authorized = \$113 million
- Estimated levy impact (at levy limit)
 - Levy up 2.3%
 - Mill rate *down* 0.1%
 - Taxes on average value home up 2.8% (value up 3%)
 - Total mill rate might be down between 0.5 and 1 mill (MMSD up slightly; MATC down ~1 mill)

Capital Budgets 2000 to 2015



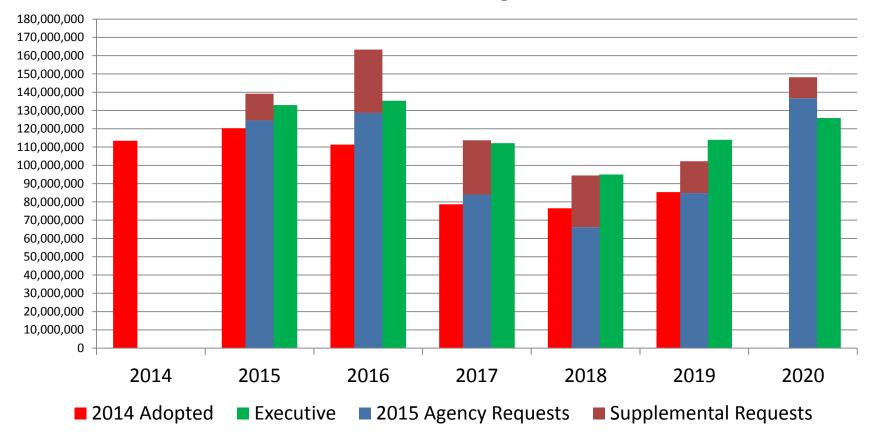
GO-New GO-Reauth Other — Actual GO Borrowing

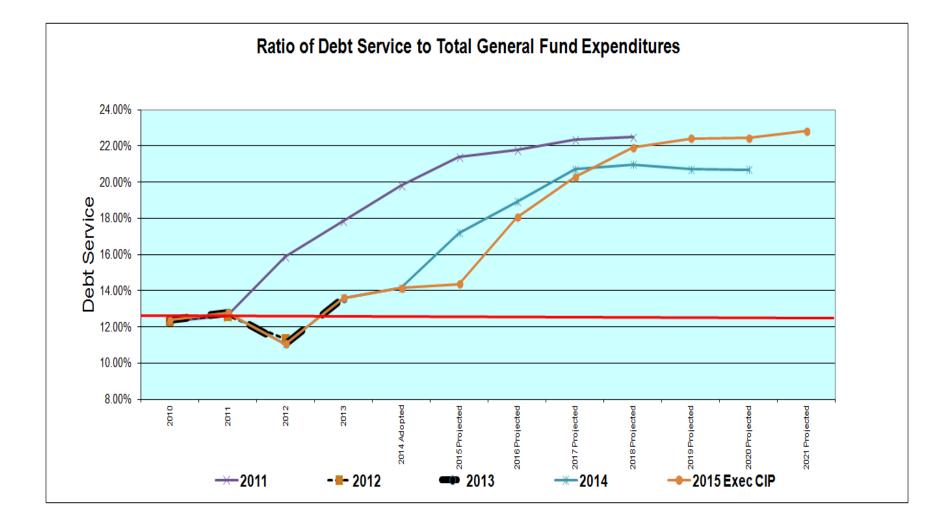
Out Year General Fund CIP Increases

- Municipal Building Renovation 2015-19
 - \$30 million general fund supported GO
 - \$26 million in 2014-16 in 2014 CIP
- Midtown Police District Station 2018/19
 - \$8.9 million general fund supported GO
 - \$1.2 million in 2014 in 2014 CIP
- Police Evidence and Vehicle Storage 2018
 - \$15.7 million general fund supported GO
 - \$3.3 million in 2019 in 2014 CIP

Out Year General Fund CIP Increases

- Far Westside Public Works Facility -- 2020
 - \$25 million general fund supported GO
 - First time in CIP in many years.
- Neighborhood Centers
 - \$19 million general fund supported GO
 - \$9.4 million in in 2014 CIP
- Affordable Housing
 - \$3.8 million general fund supported GO
 - First time in CIP
