Dear ALRC Members:

I understand that the Tiki Shack liquor license application is going to be referred back from Council tonight to your agenda tomorrow night. I recommend that the Committee refer the application to its December meeting due to the following rather serious issues surrounding the operation of the establishment under the new applicants:

1) The applicant, Caleb Percevecz, has two pending criminal charges (Substantial Battery and Disorderly Conduct) from an incident occurring at the end of October. The cases are currently set for a Status Conference on December 1, 2014.

2) There was a fight at the bar this past weekend involving a 15 year old and a 19 year old who were allegedly in the establishment and at least one of them had been consuming alcohol.3) It is my understanding that Joe Vale, the current liquor license holder, is no longer involved with the establishment and he may not even be in town. Thus, the new owners are unlawfully operating under Mr. Vale's license.

I believe these issues call into question whether the new application should be granted and the issues should be more fully explored and considered.
