Project Scope

- Replace asphalt pavement & base
- Install new curb & gutter, replace drive aprons
- Replace sanitary sewer & water mains
- Install new storm sewer



Location





Street Improvement Details

- Existing Street
 - Asphalt pavement, average rating 3 &4 out of 10
 - No curb and gutter
 - Existing sidewalk
- Street Improvements
 - New asphalt pavement & stone base
 - Install concrete curb & gutter & drive aprons and replace sidewalk as needed for City utility work
 - New storm sewer as part of new curb & gutter



City Utility Replacement Details

- Sanitary Sewer
 - Existing main 1941, 6" clay, located in terrace
 - Proposed 8" PVC, located under the pavement
- Water Main
 - Existing main 1940, 6" spun cast iron
 - Proposed 8" Ductile Iron

New Parking Configuration

- Alternate side parking only applies to street blocks with parking on both sides
- Owen Drive is too narrow (28') to have parking on both sides
- Alternating the sides of the street that parking is on allows for alternate side parking and snow plowing







Street Assessment Policy & Costs

* Curb & Pavement assessed per linear ft. of frontage

Construction

- Road closed during project, local traffic only
- Street parking removed during working hours (7am-7pm) for project duration
- Residential driveways accessible for most of project but closed up to a cumulative total of 21 days, notified before
- Likely 2 planned water shutoffs, notified before
- Sanitary sewer will be out of service for a couple of hours when new lateral is connected to existing.

Tree removals, as shown on plan, were identified by City Eorestry.

- BPW Public Hearing 12/17/14
- CC Hearing 1/6/15
- Advertise for Bids 1/23/15
- Start Construction- 3/30/15 at earliest
