

Project Scope & Schedule

Scope

- Full Street Reconstruction
- Replace curb & gutter, pavement, base course and drive aprons. Sidewalk & Ramps as needed.
- Replace sanitary sewer, water main and storm sewer systems.
- Realign Bike Path Crossing at N Charter St \ Spring St Intersection
- Replace RR Crossing of N Charter Street

Preliminary Construction Schedule

Construction during UW summer break: May 18, 2015 to August 31, 2015



Existing Conditions:





- Pavement ratings 3 to 4 out of 10
- Curb ratings 3 to 6 out of 10 some curb & gutter will be saved
- Storm Sewer 1920's 12–15" clay and concrete pipe
- ▶ Sanitary Sewer 1920's 6"–8" clay pipe
 - Water Mains 4" 1880's, 6" 1921

Existing Conditions:





- Ongoing UW steam tunnel project
 - City will complete restoration of street following completion of UW project.

Proposed Utilities

N. Charter Street


- New Ductile Iron Water Main and Copper Laterals
- New 8" Sanitary Sewer Main and New Laterals to Each Property
- Upgrade Storm Sewer to concrete pipe and improve drainage

Spring Street

- Replace Water Main and InstallNew Copper Laterals
- Existing Sanitary Sewer is owned by MMSD. Work on sanitary sewer is currently not planned.
- Upgrade Storm Sewer to concrete pipe and improve drainage

Diagonal Intersection Crossing

- Improves visibility
- Improves bike and pedestrian safety



Signalized Bike Path Crossing



New Signal

- Existing Condition:
 - -All way Stop
 - -Bike Path has right of way
- Signal will designate bike path as having right of way
- Other vehicles will get green when detected



Proposed Street Tree Removals



(8) Proposed Tree Removals:

- All street trees within the project limits have been evaluated by City Forestry.
- All removals are due to deteriorated condition of the tree
- (4) Are ash trees with either trunk wounds or are in decline
- (4) Are other tree species either partially dead or in decline.



Special Assessments Policy

- Owner 50% / City 50% For Replacement of Concrete Curb,
 Drive Aprons, Sidewalk & Terrace
- New Sidewalk Construction, 100% Owner Responsibility
- Owner 25% / City 75% on Sanitary Sewer Lateral
- Private Storm Sewer Connections, 100% Owner if needed
- ▶ 66 ft parcel (Typical Values)
 - \$2,500 Streets items
 - \$1,500 Sanitary Sewer
 - \$1,800 for each Storm Sewer Connection
