# Proposed North Charter Street and Spring Street Reconstruction Project - 2015

### Project Details - Proposed Work

Sanitary Sewer: Replace existing sanitary main (installed in 1920's) and replace laterals to the property line (assessable).

Water Main: Replace the existing water main (installed in 1880's & 1920's) and reconnect services to the new main.

**Storm Sewer:** Replace as necessary, reconnect private storm sewer connections per City standards (*assessable*).

Street Reconstruction: The asphalt pavement, curb and gutter and driveway aprons will be replaced within the project limits. Sidewalk will be replaced on an as needed basis. New concrete sidewalk will be constructed along the north side of Spring Street where there currently is none. The street widths are proposed to remain the same as existing. The southwest bike path will be re-aligned to cross diagonally through the N Charter/Spring Street intersection. The railroad crossing of N Charter Street will also be replaced in conjunction with the project.

Trees: City Forestry staff has reviewed the street trees within the project limits and has identified the following trees that are either damaged or in declining condition to be removed:

- 18" Norway Maple at 1202 Spring Street
- 6" White Ash at 222 N Charter Street
- 16" Green Ash at 222 N Charter Street
- 3" Japanese Tree Lilac at 117 N Charter Street (2<sup>nd</sup> tree south of Dayton St)
- 3" Japanese Tree Lilac at 117 N Charter Street (4th tree south of Dayton St)
- 18" Green Ash at 27 N Charter Street
- 33" European Ash at 1102 Spring Street (east of driveway)
- 8" American Elm at 1102 Spring Street (west of driveway)

Replanting of trees typically takes place in the spring following completion of the project. All of the trees within the project limits will be pruned by City Forestry prior to the start of construction. For more information regarding the City's policies for street tree pruning, tree removals and the Emerald Ash Borer response plan see the back of this page.

### **Construction Schedule & Impacts**


Tentative Schedule: Mid-May, 2015 through the end of August, 2015.

Traffic Impacts: North Charter Street and Spring Street will be closed to through traffic during the Construction. Access will be maintained for emergency and local traffic. Pedestrian access will be maintained on at least one side of each of the streets at all times, and access to businesses will be maintained as necessary.

Water Shut-offs: An average of two water shut-offs are expected for each property within the project limits, and the timing of these shut-offs will be coordinated as much as possible. A minimum of 48 hours of notice will be provided prior to the shut-offs. Each shut-off may last up to eight hours, but typically last about four hours.

At the start of construction, the existing main will remain in service until the new main is installed and connected to; emergency shut-offs may occur if the old, brittle main is damaged during construction.

**Refuse Collection:** It will be the contractor's responsibility to allow for refuse collection during construction. Please mark your address on your cart to make sure it is returned if moved. Please contact private collection companies to inform them of the project.

Assessments are payable as a lump sum or over eight years with 3.0% interest.

# City Forestry Street Tree Policy Information for Engineering Project - 2015

Tree pruning in advance of the project is required to reduce the risk of damage to the trees during construction. The City of Madison Forestry Section will perform the necessary work. For certain species, especially oak and elm trees, the pruning must be completed by April 1<sup>st</sup> to reduce the chance of disease. If trees need to be removed, City Forestry or City Engineering will notify the adjacent property owner prior to removal.

All ash street trees within the project limits have been or will be evaluated for potential chemical treatment for Emerald Ash Borer (EAB). Ash trees with trunks measuring less than 10" in diameter at 4.5 ft (DBH) from the ground, ash located under high voltage electric distribution lines, and ash that are structurally compromised or in poor condition will not be treated as outlined the City's EAB Plan. Ash trees that do not meet the treatment criteria will be removed prior to construction, and will be removed regardless of the construction project schedule. Including ash removals as part of the project will allow for a faster replacement timeframe. Street trees provide many benefits to our city and are considered an important part of the city's infrastructure. Forestry Section staff will evaluate the terrace for new planting sites and potential replacement sites when the project is complete. There is no additional cost to the adjacent property owner for a tree planting. Street trees are typically planted in the spring of the year following the completion of the construction project. Per Madison General Ordinance 10.10, City Forestry determines tree species and planting locations. Residents cannot choose or plant their own tree in the terrace.
