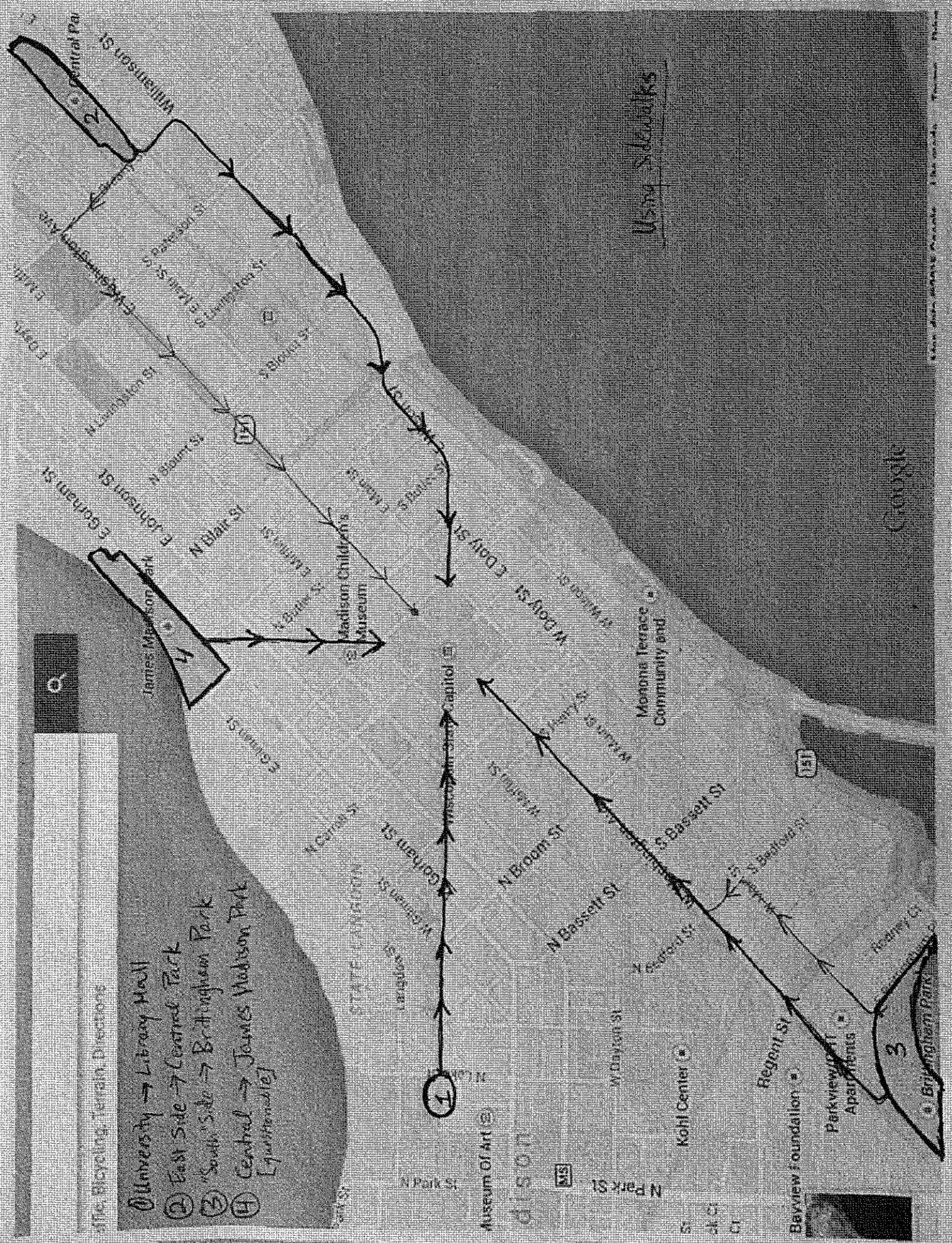

Strut! Event Description

"Strut!" on Saturday, May 2, will be the culminating event of interdisciplinary Artist-in-Residence Laura Anderson Barbata's Spring, 2015 residency through the University of Wisconsin, Madison Arts Institute (<http://artsinstitute.wisc.edu/iarp/barbata/>). It will be a New-Orleans-style parade/procession comprised of visual, musical and performing artists, campus and community groups.

We are planning to have groups gather in four different locations and walk to four distinct entry points onto the square. The starting locations are as follows:

- 1) Library/State St. Mall (note that we have met with the organizers of Revelry, and they have agreed to let our groups convene on the mall and walk through the festival area in the afternoon before the ticketed event begins).
- 2) Central Park
- 3) Brittingham Park
- 4) James Madison Park

From three of the four proposed locations (Library Mall, Central Park, Brittingham Park), all participants would use the sidewalks to get to the square. We are planning on having the larger groups, including a group of approximately 30 stilt walkers and another group of approximately 40 musicians, begin at James Madison Park, due to its proximity to the square, and the fact that there are currently no events planned in that park. We are requesting a police escort from James Madison Park to the square (via N. Hamilton St.), and around the square (2 laps if possible, within the given time frame). Groups arriving from the other three locations will feed in as the procession passes their entry point to the square. We will end at the Madison Children's Museum Funkyard.

If we cannot have an on-street escort to the square, then groups starting at James Madison would use the sidewalks, and we would like a police escort just around the square.

Our proposed event schedule is as follows:

- 1:00-1:45: Groups gather at starting locations and line up.
- 1:45-2:00: Groups leave their starting locations
- 2:00-2:15: Groups arrive at their entry points to the square
- 2:15-2:45 p.m.: "Strut!" around the square
- 2:45-3:00 p.m.: Finish at Madison Children's museum Funkyard. Groups disperse.
