NATIONAL MEDAL

MPL did have its "National Medal" Day on March 17th and we shared a lot of information about our finalist status on a variety of social media. We will find out if we have won one of the five medals on April 8th. The award and public announcement of the winners will be made in the first week of May.

LIBRARY SITING AND ALLOCATION

The Pinney Project is moving forward. Mark Benno and staff have met to review the geothermal aspect of the project. We will be able to start sharing more detailed timetables soon.

The latest I have heard on the completion of the Meadowridge Library project is May 15th.

We are in the vetting process on the Graybar property. So far there have been a couple of concerns but nothing major enough to derail the project. All-in-all it is looking good so far.

SPECIAL VISITORS AND VISITS

- I recently shared information about a workshop for board members that was being conducted by Pat Wagner. Pat is a library consultant and trainer for many library related topics and is nationally recognized for her programs. She is based in Denver and I got to know her while I was in Colorado attending her workshops. So when I saw she was in the Madison area I invited her to tour Central and talk shop. She was very impressed with the building and was very impressed with the programming and direction that MPL has taken. She shared that she will be holding MPL up as an example of a library doing great things in her library workshops.
- As part of our IMLS grant with UW Madison there were several outside advisors to provide their expertise on our project. It was great to increase awareness of the resources that we can provide to their operation in particular since they are just 1 block away from our offices.
- Krissy Wick, Youth Services Supervisor, Jenni Collins and Lau Christensen, from the MPL Foundation, and I met with Jack Salzwedel, CEO American Family to discuss MPL's early literacy initiatives.
