

Mall Concourse Sidewalk Washing Program

This program includes general pavement cleaning, detailed cleaning around benches & trash cans, and *some* gum removal, depending on time available.

Summer 2015

To be cleaned:

- Entire 100 block triangle (*100 State, N Fairchild, north side of W. Mifflin*)
- Entire Capitol Square (*excluding South and North Carroll Street that were completed in 2014*)
- 100 block Wisconsin Ave.
- 100 block N. Pinckney St.
- 100 block N. Hamilton St.
- 100 block E. Mifflin St.
- 100 block E. Washington St.
- 100 block E. Main St.
- 100 block King St.
- 100 block S. Pinckney
- 100 block Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd
- 100 block S. Carroll St.
- Library Mall

To be postponed in 2015 due to construction:

- *N. Frances St. south of State*
- *The portion of the 500 block enclosed in the construction tunnel*

Procedure

The area to be cleaned in 2015 will take us approximately 19 weeks. We plan to begin washing in Mid-April, as long as weather allows. Cleaning crews will start by 6:30am and finish by 11:30am, except on blocks which have little foot traffic and no café setups, which may run later into the day.

As we have allocated 10 hours for each side of the street per block, it will be important to adjust the thoroughness with which the pavement is cleaned in order to keep on schedule. Therefore, all pavement will be washed, but there is not enough time at this pace to remove all the gum.

Businesses on the affected blocks will be notified, with the help of a Business Improvement District representative, on the preceding Thursday. Cafés will need to delay set-up on the days we are working in front of their business until we have finished washing for the day.

Mall Concourse will utilize cones, barricades and appropriate signage to warn pedestrians of the presence of equipment, very hot water, and spray on the sidewalk.

Summer 2016

In the summer of 2016 we plan to start over with the sidewalk washing program, by beginning at the top of State Street, then working on the northwest side of the Capitol Square.
