Applicant's Comments: We would like to demo the home at 2928 Barlow St and build a new single family 2 story home. The home there is 520 square feet, built in 1928. The home is in very poor condition and its within 2 feet of the rear lot line. We would like to build a colonial home The home would have the garage positioned on the west side of the lot. Mr Allen Barkoff who lives next door is concerned about sun light. Our design will also protect his view and we will protect the large evergreen tree in front

Applicant's Comments: The project includes demolition of the existing vehicle maintenance bays and offices (8,900 sf). New, replacement construction will provide enhanced vehicle maintenance areas, employee support spaces, and administrative areas (22,700 sf). Remodeling and minor addition to the existing two and half story will provide enhanced workshop space (7,100 sf). Site development will include: re-paving the existing parking lot, new fence line, site lighting, and a new landscape terrace.
