1. What three plan recommendations do you like the most?

- Turning Vernon Avenue into a two-way.
- Additions to Rennebohm Park.
- Improvements to Garner Park pond.
- Pedestrian island on Old Middleton Road and Eau Claire Avenue.
- Additions/improvements to Robin Parkway.

2. Please list the issues you would like to have the steering committee address/refine in more detail.

- "Green" pathway from Garner to Rennebohm to get coffee. Use Kenosha Drive greenway.
- The Regent hiker and biker.
- In the part of the plan referencing the triangle, please make specific mention that SHNA be consulted regarding any future development.
- Add pedestrian/bicycle island lanes to Whitney Way the entire length of University Avenue to Raymond Road.
- Reduce size of Segoe Road between Sheboygan Avenue and Regent Street to make it more like Segoe Road to the south.
- Add speed reducing features to all roads near a park.

3. Other

- On the timeline, the Hilldale redevelopment started in 2005, not 2007.
- There is a bus stop in front of 592 North Midvale Boulevard.
