NATIONAL MEDAL

Unfortunately MPL did not receive a National Medal. It was quite an accomplishment to be nominated and make it to the finals. Even though we did not receive the medal it does reflect the dedication and hard work that MPL staff provide to our community.

LIBRARY SITING AND ALLOCATION

The Pinney Project is moving forward. Staff met with a designer to discuss possibilities of exploring our PlayLab concept.

Although not official it is expected we might be able to close on the Graybar property in May.

STRATEGIC PLANNING

I have been conducting individual interviews with the Management Team to begin to create a framework to start building a new strategic plan for MPL. We are just in the very beginning stages but the input I have received so far should really support a productive and effective plan.

We have renewed our contract with Underground for 2015-16. In 2016 we are planning to add some additional catering options for our private parties.
