Hi Jason,

I am currently auditing liquor license renewal paperwork and I came across an inconsistency with your application for 608 Restaurant and Bar. For Question #11, you indicated alcohol is being consumed both inside the restaurant and 4 tables outside patio. Your current license premise does not allow patrons to consume alcohol anywhere outside your establishment, including any type of patio. Your licensed premise can be found on your License and begins with "Premise". I have attached a Change of Premise application for you to fill out if you would like to include the patio in your licensed premise. In order for this to be taken up at the next ALRC meeting, you would need to return this by May 6 at noon. Until a Change of Premise is approved, you may not serve or have patrons consume alcohol on a patio.

You also missed question #13, which asks for estimated percentage of gross sales for liquor/beer vs. food business. Could you please reply with the following percentages:
