SUMMARY:

Darren Vollmer, registering in support and wishing to speak, and Cayle Tompkins, registering in support and available to answer questions. Mr. Vollmer described the general project and requested that the embossed relief of the columns and guard rail be removed from the sleeping porch and that the sleeping porch not retain any windows on the side.
