Dear Mr. Renaud;

Your one-lot certified survey of property located at 855 E. Main Street, Section 13, Township 7N, Range 9E, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, is hereby **conditionally approved**. The property is zoned TE (Traditional Employment District). The conditions of approval from the reviewing agencies to be satisfied prior to final approval and recording of the CSM are:

Please contact Janet Schmidt of the City Engineering Division at 261-9688 if you have questions regarding the following eight (8) items:

- 1. The Operations building shall use the address of 110 S. Paterson Street.
- 2. Correct the bearing along the south line of the SW ¼ of Section 13. The bearing should be S 88\mathbb{2}53'32" E. Also correct that same bearing in the legal description under the Surveyor's Certificate.
- 3. Turn off/freeze point labels left on in the drawing.
- 4. It is suggested to insert the quarter-quarters into the title and legal description to allow additional cross referencing within the section at the Register of Deeds office.
- 5. The following note shall be placed on the CSM: "No changes in drainage patterns associated with development on any or all lots within this CSM shall be allowed without prior approval of the City Engineer."
- 6. A minimum of 2 working days prior to requesting City Engineering Division signoff on the CSM, the applicant shall contact Janet Schmidt (261-9688) to obtain the final stormwater utility charges that are due and payable prior to sub-division of the properties. The stormwater utility charges (as all utility charges) are due for the previous months of service. All charges shall be cleared prior to the land division (and subsequent obsolesces of the existing parcel).

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- 7. Wisconsin Administrative Code A-E 7.08 identifies when Public Land System (PLS) tie sheets must be filed with the Dane County Surveyor's office. The Developer's Surveyor and/or Applicant must submit copies of required tie sheets or condition reports for all monuments, including center of sections of record, used in this survey, to Eric Pederson, City Engineering. If a new tie sheet is not required under A-E 7.08, Engineering requests a copy of the latest tie sheet on record with Dane County Surveyor's office. The applicant shall identify monument types on all PLS corners included on the Plat. Note: Land tie to two PLS corners required.
- 8. Prior to approval, the owner or owner's representative shall obtain a permit to plug each existing sanitary or storm sewer lateral that serves a building which is proposed for demolition. For each lateral to be plugged the owner shall complete a sewer lateral plugging application and pay the applicable permit fees. NOTE: As of January 1, 2013, new plugging procedures and permit fees are in effect.

- 9. Executed signature block certifications shall be included for all parties of interest, pursuant to Wis. Stats. 236.21(2)(a). All ownership consents and certifications for the subject lands shall conform to Wis. Stats. 236.21(2) and 236.29 by including the language "...surveyed, divided, mapped and dedicated..."
- 10. For parcels located within the City of Madison, a Madison Common Council Certificate shall appear as follows:

11. Prior to final CSM sign-off, please verify with Janet Schmidt of the City Engineering Division (261-9688) or Pam Mousley at the Water Utility (261-9132) that stormwater management fees are paid in full.

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency.

A resolution approving the CSM and authorizing the City to sign it and any other documents related to the proposed land division was approved by the Common Council on <u>June 2</u>, <u>2015</u>.

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As soon as the comments and conditions have been satisfied as verified with a completed affidavit form (attached), the original along with the revised Certified Survey Map, with all signatures and approvals from the reviewing agencies, shall be brought to this office for final signoff. You or your client may then record the certified survey at the Dane County Register of Deeds. For information on recording procedures and fees, contact the Register of Deeds at 266-4141.

Prior to City Engineering final sign-off by the main office of the CSM, the final CSM shall be submitted to the Engineering Division Surveyor/ Land Records Coordinator for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two working days prior to final Engineering Division signoff. Email submittal of the final CSM in PDF form is preferred. Transmit to jrquamme@cityofmadison.com.

The owner shall furnish to the Office of Real Estate Services and the survey firm preparing the CSM an updated title report covering the period between the date of the initial title report and the date when final signoff is requested. The surveyor shall update the CSM with the most recent information reported in the title update.

Upon acceptance and recording of the Certified Survey Map by the Dane County Register of Deeds, please transfer the recorded volume, document number, and page numbers to the copies and forward a copy to this office for our records. The original survey map with the recording information is permanently kept on file in the Dane County Register of Deeds Office. A copy of the recorded document can be obtained from the Register of Deeds Office, Room 110, City-County Building or the Real Estate Office in the Madison Department of Planning and Development.

Any appeal from this action, including the conditions of approval, must be filed with the Circuit Court within 30 days from the date of this letter. The approval of this CSM shall be null and void if not recorded in twelve (12) months from the date of the approving resolution or this letter, whichever is later.
