Description of Modification Request:

Hovde Project Drain Piping Coordination Documentation - \$1,800

- Create coordination exhibits showing plans and sections of the drain piping serving the third floor above the Fire Administration space.
- Develop exhibits for all areas where 13" dimension was exceeded by Core & Shell developer for review by the City of Madison staff.
- Create Revit drawings (plans and sections) showing the interface of the ductwork and piping.

Additional cost estimate (design team coordination time only) - \$1,550

- Solicit proposals (Turis & Middleton)
- Assemble 98% documents set for estimator
- Answer estimator's questions
