DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: In recognition of the fact that disability rights are civil rights, the commissioners request that the name of the Commission on People with Disabilities be changed to the Commission on Disability Rights. In addition this change would better highlight the focus on the rights of people with disabilities, as opposed to the focus being people with disabilities themselves.
